Show Jumping/Cross Country Annual Disclaimer Form

Horse riding is a dangerous sport and you participate at your own risk. Due care has been taken to maintain the course in a safe condition, but riders must observe the following rules and any additional instruction that may be given. No rider will be allowed to jump unless a valid copy of this form is lodged with the EEC.

- The course must be used in a sensible manner compatible with the level of experience of the rider and horse or pony.
- Riders must follow the pre-planned route at ALL times. Any rider found off the course will be asked to leave the Estate; monies will not be refunded.
- Riders must participate with due care and attention. Please be aware of other people using the estate. Overtaking on the course must be permitted; the overtaking horse must do so in a safe and suitable manner.
- Do not hold up other riders at fences. Allow others to pass before attempting to continue.
- Unaccompanied riders should advise the starter and ensure their emergency contact details are up to date. Note that there will be no first aid cover present. It is recommended that riders carry a mobile phone.
- It is a condition of entry that all riders comply with the secretary and stewards at all times. Failure to do so will result in the rider being removed from the course.
- Any damage to fences or other equipment must be reported to the organisers as soon as possible. Others must be prevented from attempting a damaged fence for their own safety.
- Please do not muck out lorries/trailers into the lorry park, take all rubbish and droppings away.
- No dogs permitted on the estate.
- Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.

Disclaimer and Conditions of Use

We have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the safety of horse and rider. You must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring. The Edinburgh Equestrian Centre reserves the right to remove someone from the course in the event of dangerous riding, abuse of the course, or failure to act with common courtesy.

Neither Edinburgh Equestrian Centre nor any person acting on behalf of the establishment accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.

ANY PERSON USING THIS COURSE DOES SO AT THEIR OWN RISK

No rider under 16 to ride without parental consent. Back protectors are highly recommended for your own safety and current standard crash helmets (PAS015, EN1384 or ASTM F1163) are compulsory.

I hereby agree to abide by the rules as documented and any additional requirements given to me by Edinburgh Equestrian Centre; I understand that by breaching any of the above I will be asked to leave the course.
