

RULES - 2010
Lothian's Riding Club

1. All horses to be 4 years and over and 14 hh and over. Passport maybe checked for height verification.
2. All riders must be 17 years and over. 17 & 18 year olds must provide proof of age.
3. A hard hat to EN1384 or PAS015 must be worn, with a dark cover, by all mounted riders whether competing or not. All hats prefixed SEI or ASTM are not acceptable. A chin strap, which has a non-detachable retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points, should be used. Any rider found to be using a hat to a lower specification will be disqualified.
4. Neither the organizers of this event, nor any person acting on their behalf, the owners of the show ground or the agents acting on their behalf, accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
5. Lothian's Riding Club members will receive league table points. Points allocated to 6th place. **Show Jumping Points will only be awarded for the first three classes members enter. To qualify for Points your Membership must be fully paid up in advance of any show, those who re join or join at a show are not able to qualify for the points at that show.**
6. The Judges decision is final. Any complaints to be made in writing to the secretary and accompanied by £20. The complaint must be made within one hour of the incidence.
7. Canter allowed **ONLY** in the practice and competition areas.
8. **BHS Riding Club Rules apply.**
9. Lothian's Riding Club reserves the right to refuse entries and classes must be entered prior to start of class. **NO ENTRIES WILL BE TAKEN ONCE CLASS HAS STARTED. CLASSES WILL NOT BE HELD UP TO WAIT FOR COMPETITORS ARRIVING LATE OR WHO ARE NOT READY TO COMPETE AT THE CORRECT TIME.**
10. All classes must be **paid for in advance** of the class and **entry fees only refunded** if the show is cancelled or the classes are full. Entries will not be accepted after the start of each class.
11. Riders competing IN THE FIRST CLASS are not eligible to compete in the LAST CLASS (UNLESS ON A DIFFERENT HORSE).
12. All competitors MUST be smartly dressed with correct riding hat and footwear and if possible smart jacket
13. HORSES AND RIDERS MUST REMOVE ANY RUGS BEFORE THEY ENTER THE ARENA. Lothian's Riding Club officials are not responsible for removing rugs from horses entering the arena.
14. Riders who fall off during the competition must be deemed fit to continue riding and if they wish to do so they do it entirely at their own risk.
